Partridge Stepping Stone Show Series Rules & Regulations

- Limited Stabling (including overnight stalls) is available- \$50 (includes shavings & HST & Clean Up)
- Open warm up prior to each division (u/s only)
- Non-Judged schooling card o/f warm up round
- Trainers are welcome to enter the ring during schooling card warm up (multiple horses with the same trainer are welcome if preferred)
- Trotting for lead changes is permitted in all o/f and pole classes and will not be penalized
- Trotting the entire Cross Rails o/f is permitted and will not be penalized (however it is recommended that either the entire course is trotted or the entire course is cantered, not a combination of both)
- Riders will not be eliminated after 2 refusals or going off course. Schooling with trainer will be permitted for a reasonable amount of time.
- 2012 Negative Coggins and OEF (or proof of insurance) is required.
- Entries must be received by 11:59pm Wednesday prior to each show. E-mail entries are welcome.
- Any late entries will be charged \$15 admin fee (after 11:59pm Wednesday prior to show)
- Only one horse/rider combination per entry form
- Rider age as of January 1st 2012
- Adults are permitted to ride ponies and ponies are allowed in all divisions
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- Approved Head Gear is mandatory. All riders must wear proper fitting, approved protective head gear, with safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted in competition or on event grounds. Approved head gear must meet the ASTM standards.
- Please respect the facility and use garbage cans provided
- Please be ready to enter the ring at designated times. We would like to ensure an efficiently run horse show
- Year End Banquet & Awards Party will be scheduled in November/December

Stepping Stone Championship Hunter Classic Specifications:

- ✓ Open to horse/rider combinations in Short/Long Stirrup, Pre Green & Mod. Child/Adult Divisions
- ✓ Riders must have participated in 4 out of 6 shows
- ✓ Only the top five horse/rider combinations from each division are eligible to participate
- ✓ Total 15 horse/rider combinations (5 from each of the above divisions) will participate in Round 1
- ✓ Top 10 combinations will return for Round 2
- ✓ Special Ribbons & prize money for top 10 combinations
- ✓ Judged as a Hunter Classic

Medal Finals Specifications:

- ✓ Riders must have participated in 4 out of 6 shows
- ✓ There will be four sections (My First Medal, Children's, Junior & Adult Medal)
- ✓ Only the top six riders from each section qualify for finals
- ✓ Format:
 - Round 1: Jumping/Pole Phase (All riders participate)
 - Round 2: Flat Phase (top ½ returns)
 - Round 3: Top 2 Test
- ✓ Special Ribbons for top 6 riders

Year-End Awards

- To qualify for year-end awards riders must participate in 4 out of 6 shows
- Riders collect points not horses (except in the Pre-Green Hunter & Mod Child/Adult Hunter Divisions)
- Points from the top 4 shows will count for year-end awards
- Points from top 4 shows will also count for overall placing for the Grand Finale "Mini Royal" special qualifying classes (i.e. Stepping Stone Championship Hunter Classic & Medal Finals)
- Year-end awards will be presented to the top 5 in each division
- Special awards will be presented
